

How to borrow

Selections of Bag Books are stocked in all Bromley libraries.

Please see separate leaflet for a complete list of titles available at Library.

Due to their size and format Bag Books are stored away from public view but can be requested from staff.

To borrow a Bag Book you will need a current Bromley library card for yourself or your child. If you are not already a library member you can join for free either online or by coming into one of our branches and showing one proof of identity which states your name and address.

Bag Books are loaned for 3 weeks. You can return them earlier or renew them for longer by telephoning via your online library account or by visiting any Bromley library.

Bag Books can be returned to any Bromley library.

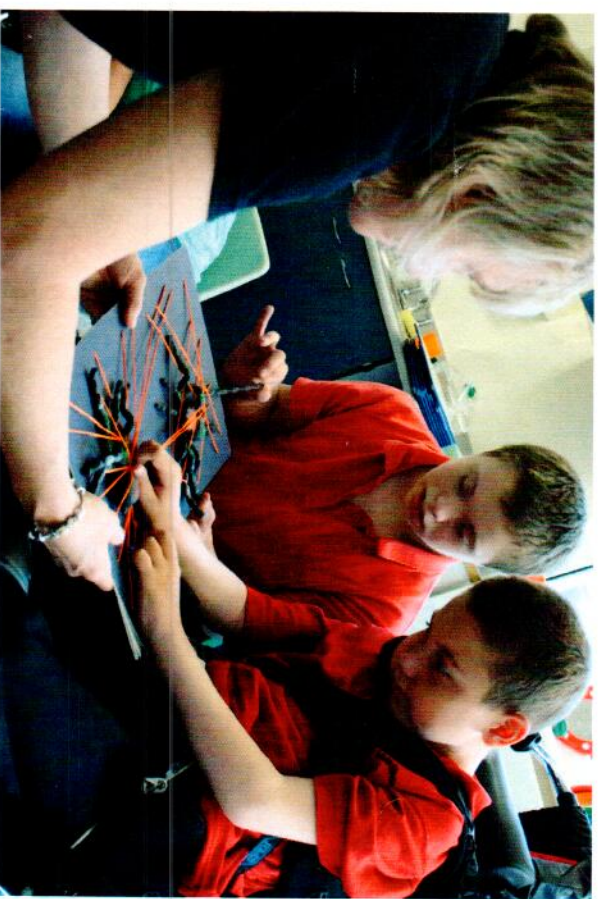
Damaged Bag Books

What are Bag Books?

For those of you that are not familiar with them, Bag Books are A3-sized multi-sensory stories that come in a box with a handle. Each story is made up of separate page cards, each of which has an object for the children to hear, smell or feel.



These are designed for children with profound and multiple learning difficulties, people with severe learning disabilities and young people on the autistic spectrum. They are also hugely beneficial to those with visual and hearing impairments.

These books are intended to capture the listeners interest and can be used for both leisure and learning.

A great deal of fun can be had by both the listener and the teller and they can be shared with siblings and friends very easily.
