Aim:	What this might look like / possible projects:
To develop the idea of focus groups to tackle projects / issues rather than a 'school council' which remains the same for long periods of time	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Regular small focus groups to look at specific projects • Pupils to self-nominate / be nominated to work on specific projects • Key classes to vote for which pupils should represent their views
To enable all groups of pupils to be 'heard' by ensuring a cross section of all ages / phases and abilities are represented in focus groups throughout the year	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Focus group pupils to change each time we change project • Pupils involved to include non-verbal as well as verbal pupils, use of AAC to ensure all voices are heard. • Age appropriateness to be considered in each project
