What does a Parent Carer Forum do?

A parent carer forum is a group of parents/carers of children and young people with SEND (Special Educational Needs and Disabilities) who work in partnership with the local authority, education, health and other providers. This is to ensure services in their area are informed by families' lived experience when planning around the needs of disabled children and their families.

How does it work?

Developing a partnership with and listening to parents helps professionals to understand what needs to happen to develop services that meet families' needs. By working together parents can inform decision makers about their lived experiences and ensure that parent /carer views are shared, thus informing decisions about services at a strategic level. In doing so, they help develop and improve effective services for disabled children, young people, and their families.

Who can join?

Parents or carers of a child with any type of special educational need or disability are welcome to join.

Will I have to attend lots of meetings?

Joining a parent/ carer forum does not mean you have to commit lots of time. Come and meet with the forum, find out more and decide if it is for you.
