Dear Families,

I hope that you have all had a good week. As promised in previous letters, we will continue to update you on a weekly basis should any of our pupils or staff receive a positive COVID-19 test result across the school and we will of course inform you immediately if your child is directly affected. I am pleased to report that we have had **no positive cases** at Riverside School this week.

In last week's letter, I referred to some of the events that had been planned for the last month of term and we are in the process of finalising arrangements for Parents' Evenings on Wednesday 7th July (secondary-aged pupils at SPC) and Thursday 8th July (primary-aged pupils on all three sites).
