## Coronavirus Update

Following our letter of 10<sup>th</sup> March, we are continuing to review the guidance issued by the DFE on a daily basis. In the light of the complex needs of our pupils, we are continually considering precautionary measures that will help to reduce risk of the spread of the Coronavirus (COVID-19). With immediate effect, we have stopped all non-essential visitors from coming onto school premises.

We are also aware of the potential heightened anxieties of our pupils, families and staff and have therefore postponed all educational visits; offsite activities; shows and family events, until the situation is more settled.

We also felt it was appropriate to advise you that we are aware of two confirmed cases of COVID-19 in people connected to the Riverside Community but would like to re-assure you that neither have been on Riverside School premises.

We continue to follow current guidance that schools should remain open however, are putting preparations in place for any changes to this situation. We have added additional resources to our website for you to share with your child should they stay at home. If your child is not able to attend school and you would like to borrow suitable resources for home use, please contact your class teacher to discuss arrangements.

In line with current Government guidance, if you or a member of your household are unwell with a new continuous cough or high temperature, the whole household should remain home in isolation for 14 days. **Please do not send your child into school.** We will contact you every other day to see how you and your child are. Our staff team are following the same guidance.
